

There are two ways to play the game. Younger children count from 1 to 100. The person that reaches 100 first, by reaching grandma's and grandpa's house, wins the game. Older children count numbers 1 to 100 adding game cards to the game, to learn safety, strategy and decision making. It is truly a board game that grows with your children. Providing hours of education, entertainment and enjoyment.
