# How to play the Game?

- Place the game board on a table or floor where you choose to play the game
- Take the state cards and capital cards that have been cut out, and place them in a jar to be mixed (8 to 10-ounce mixing jar not provided)
- Every player chooses a letter card and token stand (not provided)
- Players will determine the order of play by deciding who will go first, second, third, or fourth. The first player selects a card from the jar; if the card is a state card, the player must know where the state is on the map. If the player knows, the state is added to his collection. If not, the card is placed back into the jar.
- **STATE CARDS:** when players receive ten state cards, they can add a letter to the game, having an additional turn on the next play.
- CAPITAL CARDS When a player picks a Capital card, they must name the capital of the state they have landed on. If the answer is correct, the player adds the capital card to their collection
- THE GAME OVER game is over when the players have answered all the state cards; the winner is the player with the most state and capital cards.

## **Delivering Across America**

**Game Pieces Includes downloads:** 1 double-sided game board, ten letter tokens, 50 state cards, 50 capital cards [not included one jar for mixing state cards and capital cards] [not included card stands for ten tokens].

#### THE DELIVERING ACROSS AMERICA BOARD GAME INSTRUCTIONS

**Game design for K - Junior High** Players learn the geography of the USA States and the Capitals. Each player takes a turn choosing a card from the jar containing the names of the states and Capitals. When a player correctly places and names the state on the map where they are located, the card is added to their collection. If a player picks a capital card from the jar and can name the state's capital on which their token has landed, they can also add the capital card to their collection. If not, the cards are placed in the draw stack till the end of the game.

After a player collects 10 Capital cards, they many add another Letter card to the game board, giving them two plays on their turn and repeat the process, depending on the players decision for the game. The winner will be the player that has collected the most state and capital cards.

### **FEATURES & DETAILS**

- Double sided 12 x 18 game board.
- Designed for two levels of gameplay, younger children use a game board showing the names of each state.
- The opposite side of the game board displays no names of the states; players will have to know the location and names of each state.
- 50 game cards uniquely designed representing all the states of the United States.
- 50 cards designed as letters representing the capitals of each state in the United States.
- 20 Letters, tokens, and Designs in different colors representing each player.[token stands are not included and can be purchased on Amazon].
- 18 or 10-ounce jar To mix game cards, they can be purchased on Amazon or in a house jar.
